SPECTATOR GUIDE

Spectator Safety

Spectators may watch Rally New York USA only from designated Spectator Areas supervised by trained Safety Marshals and equipped with emergency radio communications and other emergency services. The access to each Spectator Area is along a separate access road and not over the Special Stage road. Spectators are prohibited from entering and walking along the Special Stage road. For your safety, please obey the instructions of Safety Marshals in the Spectator Areas.

Please drive safely and obey speed limits
We never race on public roads open to regular traffic

Spectator Areas are on Friday in Monticello (Sullivan County) and on Saturday in Walton (Delaware County) – see directions and times on page 2 of this Guide and refer to published Course Maps. Rally Headquarters is in Walton, New York.

Spectator Area at Concord Resort and Golf Club
in Monticello / Thompson (Sullivan County)

ADMISSION: \$10 per car or \$5 per person on foot

This is a spectacular amphitheater-like Spectator Area where you can sit on the side of the hill and watch rally cars passing over a long section of this tarmac special stage in both directions and watch servicing of rally cars in the Service Park nearby.

Directions: Exit 105 on Route 17 Quickway, take Route 42 north and turn right onto Concord Road after the shopping center. **PARK IN THE DESIGNATED AREA off the road. No parking on Concord Road!**

Friday, April 16, 2010 3:00 PM – 8:00 PM Cars will pass six times!

Spectator Area at Sunset Hay Farm on Dunk Hill Road
in Walton (Delaware County)

ADMISSION: \$10 per car or \$5 per person on foot

A large Spectator Area with multiple viewing points overlooking a long section of this special stage. Approach from Walton driving east on Route 22, turn left on Fish Hollow Road and left on Dunk Hill.

PARK ONLY IN THE DESIGNATED AREA ON THE FARM. No parking anywhere on Dunk Hill Road!

Welcome Rally New York USA 2010!

The rally drivers from all over the United States and from abroad will compete in this exciting event. The course is 346 miles long with 90.5 miles of Special Stages. Rally New York USA 2010 is the second round of the United States Rally Championship. It also counts toward the New York Rally Championship – Thunder 102 Cup. We are grateful to the Governments of the Town of Walton, Walton Chamber of Commerce, Town of Thompson, Sullivan County Visitors Association, Delaware County Economic Development, local fire departments and emergency medical services, local business and civic organizations, residents and local businesses, sponsors, law enforcement personnel, countless volunteers and amateur radio operators for their support.

What is a Stage Rally?

It is a car rally with a number of Special Stages linked together by transit sections. The rally cars are typically small sedans such as Subaru Impreza or Mitsubishi Evo. On the Special Stages on public roads closed to civilian traffic, the rally cars start at one-minute intervals and race against the clock. On the transit sections, the rally cars drive in regular traffic and obey all traffic laws. If a competitor is observed speeding on a transit section, he is penalized and may be disqualified from the rally.
