2010 CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS

Rally New York, Ltd. (www.RallyNewYork.com) declares the following Regulations for the 2010 New York Rally Championship sponsored by Tearoff Guys (www.tearoffguys.com) and presented by Thunder 102 Rally Radio (www.thunder102.com).

New York and the Northeast of the United States are the home of many rally teams. In the 2010 season, we will continue providing for these teams the opportunity to participate in the regional New York Rally Championship, a tradition we started with the 2007 season. Never before in the history of US rallying had these teams the opportunity to take part in a meaningful regional rally championship without traveling to distant locations in order to participate in automobile rally competition.

The 2010 New York Rally Championship season will run from January 2010 to December 2010.

2. Championship Categories

- All-Wheel Drive (AWD)
- Two-Wheel Drive (2WD)
- Pre-Modern All-Wheel Drive (Pre-Mod AWD)

The Pre-Mod AWD category will include all all-wheel drive cars that preceded the latest models such as Mitsubishi Lancer Evolution from its inception or Subaru Impreza from its inception. Drivers of these cars will designate at their option one of the two AWD categories.

The winners in the three categories will be known as the 2010 New York Rally AWD Champion, the 2010 New York Rally 2WD Champion and the 2010 New York Rally Pre-Mod AWD Champion. There will be separate Championships for Drivers and Co-drivers in each category.

3. Production Cup

Production cars running in the Championships outlined in Section 2. above will also score in the following Production Cup competitions:

- Production All-Wheel Drive (AWD) Cup
- Production Two-Wheel Drive (2WD) Cup

The winners will be known as the 2010 New York Rally Championship AWD Production Cup Winner and the 2010 New York Rally Championship 2WD Production Cup Winner. There will be a separate classification for Drivers and Co-drivers.

4. Event Points

The points for placing in the Categories above will be awarded in the following manner:

1 st place	20 points	9 th place	7 points
2 nd	18	10 th	6
3 rd	16	11 th	5
4 th	14	12 th	4
5 th	12	13 th	3
6 th	10	14 th	2
7 th	9	15 th	1
8 th	8	All other finishers	1

In addition, 4 (four) points will be awarded for starting the event, provided that the crew and the car passes through the first time control of the event.

5. Points-paying Events

Championship points will be awarded for the results from the following regional rallies:

1. January 23	New York Winter Rally – Day 1	snow / gravel
2. January 24	New York Winter Rally – Day 2	snow / gravel
3. April 16	Rally New York USA – Day 1	tarmac
4. April 17	Rally New York USA – Day 2	tarmac
5. June 19	Summer Rallysprint	gravel
6. September 10	International Rally New York – Day 1	gravel
7. September 11	International Rally New York – Day 2	gravel
8. October 23	Autumn Rallysprint	gravel

Competitors will be able to count up to **six best results** toward the 2010 New York Rally Championship. With eight events on the Calendar, competitors will **no longer** be able to improve their best scores by **counting any out-of-the-area events**.

In order to be insured under the Rally New York Motorsport Insurance Plan, competitors will purchase a Rally New York competition license for a nominal fee of \$50, valid for the calendar year, with no additional membership fee. Visiting foreign competitors may use their licenses with a letter of approval from the entity that issued the license.

6. Awards

The New York Rally Champions and Production Cup Winners will be honored at the traditional “Night of Champions” that will be held in the New York City area in early December, 2010.
